


## Advantages of soil mulching in agriculture (part 1)

Mulching is a well-established practice in annual and perennial crops, aiming to form a physical barrier between the soil and the atmosphere, allowing water evaporation reduction, increasing water content in the soil, reducing weed pressure, maintaining high soil temperatures and generally inducing better growing condition for plants and enhanced yield compared to no-mulching.

## Advantages of soil mulching in agriculture (part 2)

In most cases, RO and D can be negligible, when drip irrigation is used. The ETc, then, is the primary factor to extract water from the soil by plant transpiration which is beneficial, and soil water evaporation which is pure loss of water.
